### **Meeting Locations and Responsibilities**

In addition to SGI-USA facilities, please ensure that there are meeting locations for the August 24<sup>th</sup> activity which are accessible all the men in your organization, including those who live some distance from an SGI center. When feasible, please also schedule a daytime meeting for men who work in the evening. Please have a reporting leader assigned for each location. Meeting locations and the names of reporting leaders should be collected as quickly as possible. The details of collecting reports will be communicated at the local level.

The reporting leader is responsible for:

- Reporting the attendance at each meeting by phone right after the meeting.
- Returning the signature sheets (please see details below.)

### **Signature Sheets**

### **Printing/Copying Directions**

Print or copy the signature sheet using black ink on white 20 lb. stock paper. Please ensure that you have enough signature sheets for each location.

## **Who Can Sign**

Any men's division member who attends an August 24<sup>th</sup> meeting or meeting place on August 24<sup>th</sup> can sign. Signatures should not be collected at home visitations or in venues other than the meeting places with the sole exception of men who are physically unable to attend the meeting, such as those who are currently in a hospital.

## **How to Sign**

Every man should sign his name in black ink neatly inside the boxes on the sheet. Multiple sheets can be available for signature simultaneously at large meeting locations.

## **How to Return**

The reporting leader should mail (unfolded) or drop off the signature sheets on August 25<sup>th</sup> directly to the territory office. Please write **August 24<sup>th</sup> Meeting** on the back of the envelope.
